Day 1 August 25, 2025	Gratitude. Let's come before God with hearts full of praise. Thank Him for the gift of life, your family & friends, work, good health, school and ministry. Psalm 9:1, Psalm 100:4 & Psalm 9:1-2
Day 2 August 26, 2025	Opening my own doors. There are blessings that come directly from God and those that come from God through people. Let's ask God to give the grace to love all people, because He first loved us. God is Love. 1 Corinthians 11:27-30, James 5:15
Day 3 August 27, 2025	Entertaining Angels. Let's ask God to help us learn to discern the body of Christ and to see God in men. God does not do anything in the earth without the help of people. He speaks and sends us messages through people. Hebrews 13:2-3, Genesis 18:1-10

General Prayer Points to be Prayed Every Day of the Fast

- 1. Pray for the salvation of your loved ones. Mention them by name as you pray for them / Pray for boldness and opportunities to invite people to church so that they can find a healthy and godly community for themselves.
- 2. Pray that you and others will experience freedom, healing, and deliverance in your life, so that you will enjoy life at its fullest and be released to your next level in life / Pray that people will participate in Freedom and community through iGroups, and also for more people to start new iGroups.
- 3. Pray that God will touch people's hearts to start serving in the house of God and build His Kingdom.
- 4. Pray that God will reveal to individuals what they need to do to help people outside of the four corners of the church (iMissions).
